- a. Everyone should be online this year for M-STEP. A few people can get a waiver but it is not something that is encourage unless you must have it.
- b. New science standards will be in field testing for two years. Still at 5th and 8th grade and including 11th grade. Planning on 45 minutes for the test. Longer next year when we get to the full test. The students are required to take it but not counted in the scoring. Field test is testing the test not the students.
- c. PSAT will be in grades 9 & 10. 2019 PSAT-ACT may be used in 8th grade test for Math and English.
- d. Benchmark assessments will be collected and are working on a proposal for next year.
